ith so many remarkable stallions in the UK, it can be hard to choose the best match for your mare. To help narrow your stallion search, start

by researching graded stallions.

At a studbook grading, sport horse experts grade stallions on their conformation, temperament, way of going and their potential to sire future athletes, so will give you some idea of what your foal could potentially achieve.

The stallions listed here have all been recently graded with Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain (SHB GB), the Anglo European Stud Book (AES) or the Sports Pony Studbook Society (SPSS).

# **BILLY MEXICO**

Credentials: 2005, 16.1hh by prolific show jumping stallion Cevin Z out of Bidorett

Performance record: Already a proven sire, show jumping stallion Billy Mexico is by Cevin Z whose daughter Borough PennyZ (BE G1E) is one of a handful of Grade 1 Elite mares. He is also the sire of Billy Walk On, champion six year old in 2015, and reserve champion seven year

# WHAT DOES BE GIE MEAN?

Horses start to earn grading points when competing from Novice level upwards and there are four grades: Grade 1 Elite (250 or more BE points), Grade 1 (61 to 250 BE points), Grade 2 (21 to 60 BE points) and Grade 3 (1 to 20 BE points). Grade 1 Elite is a classification for horses that have attained four star level competition and/or have achieved 250 British Eventing points. Below is a list of 2016 Grade 1 Elite competing stallions:

Chilli Morning: 17hh, 16yo, chestnut by Phantomic x Koralle (1,716)

Primitive Faerie Tale: 15.3hh, 18yo chestnut by Primitive Rising x Faerie Glen (313)
